Charleston, SC- Crescent Homes closed out the first quarter of 2019 with another successful round of donations totaling \$28,250 through their philanthropic program GIVE. The private homebuilder contributes \$250 for every home sale, giving each home buyer the opportunity to choose one of five charities to dedicate their contribution to, with five new organizations selected each quarter.

Since its launch in April 2017, GIVE has raised funds for 39 Charleston non-profits totaling \$175,500. The goal of GIVE goes beyond financial contributions and aims to bring awareness to a variety of non-profit organizations and highlight the worthwhile work they do, while encouraging homeowners to get involved in their local community.

First quarter contributions and recipients include:

- \$4,000 to Trident Literacy Association
- \$3,500 to Keep Charleston Beautiful
- \$6,500 to WINGS for Kids
- \$10,000 to Eagle Harbor Kids
- \$4,500 to Carolina Coonhound Rescue
