Charleston, SC - Crescent Homes announces a total of \$84,750 given to Charleston nonprofits in 2018 through their philanthropic program, GIVE, which was founded in 2017. The private home builder pledged to give \$250 to local non-profits for every home sale. A successful fourth quarter saw \$19,750 going to four deserving groups.

The GIVE program seeks to spread its charitable giving to a multitude of groups working to support the Charleston community at every level. In order to bring awareness to various nonprofits, five new groups are selected each quarter. New home buyers are given information on each of the four nonprofits and have the opportunity to select where to send the donation in their honor.

The following local groups received donations in the 4th quarter*:

- \$4,450 to For the Exceptional
- \$3,950 to the Gibbon Sanctuary
- \$4,500 to Going Places
- \$6,950 to I Heart Hungry Kids

The Trident Literacy Association aims to put a stop to generational poverty through literacy programs, helping adults master reading, study for the GED, learn English as a second language, prepare for a career and understand basic computer skills.

The local nonprofit has been promoting a litter-free Charleston since 1977 through education programs, spreading awareness and involving the community.

[WINGS for Kids](#)

WINGS for Kids provides a safe place after school for low-income children to participate in social-emotional learning programs. The groups work directly with students to improve the ways in which they relate to others, giving them the tools and inspiration to stay in school and succeed.

[Eagle Harbor Kids](#)

Started by the Gilbert family as a place for orphaned, neglected and abused children, the Eagle Harbor Ranch is a safe haven and refuge. The ranch provides children with a caring family setting, where life skills are honed in a loving and enriching environment.

[Carolina Coonhound Rescue](#)

Carolina Coonhound Rescue provides medical assistance, training, love, and compassion for abandoned or mistreated coonhounds until a forever home can be found.

The GIVE program continues to grow alongside the company, which now extends across the southeast to Greenville, SC, and Nashville, TN.

Our expansion into the Nashville and Greenville markets has allowed us to extend our philanthropic reach to these areas as well, and we're excited to give back to the communities that have welcomed us with open arms.
